Minutes

The meeting starts at 10. Introduction by Florin, discussion on RBFA request to leave the project.

Everybody agreed on RBFA withdrawal from the project. The replacement federation could be Latvia. Radicalisation became visible in Baltic countries, especially against Russia, now even more, Estonia could be associated partner. Everybody agrees that Latvia is onboard. Loris: at least keep the French language in FAIRER communication.

Plan b) if worst case EACEA does not agree with RBFA out, FRF will convince RBFA to remain on the project, with a different person working on it.

Everything related to Belgium involvement in the FAIRER project is frozen (there are issues with bad wording in the current website)

WP2

Loris: in FAIRER we intend to address radicalisation from bottom up and top-down approach (also involving institutions). Supporters are seen as a problem. We can use them not as a problem but as a solution, together with supporters' associations. The main idea is to create a network of people: federations, clubs, supporters /fans, public authorities working against radicalisation.

Florin: how to do it? Loris: not as formal network. UNIMORE has already created a network at local level.

Part 1: research: if we include Latvia they will need some time to work on the research part.

Part 2 Discussion on target groups for the networks page. 27 of the application form describes target groups. June 2023 is the deadline for the creation of the network at national level for each federation.

These networks involving involving 20 participants will meet according to the living lab methodology for the guidelines. Discussion about facilitators: meeting 1 objectives, meeting 2 presentation of research outcomes. The clubs are the main stakeholders according to Loris. (In Bucarest Steaua, dynamo and rapid cannot sit at the same table, but handling conflict is part of the guidelines).

D.2.1 state of the art requires extension, definitely, in case we want to include Latvia.

D.2.2 first version of guidelines requires to be ready by June.
